


Towards the EU vision of a common gas market in Europe

- The Finnish gas market will be opened for competition from the beginning of 2020 when the Balticconnector-pipeline is operational
- Gas transmission business of Gasum will be unbundled from sales and supply business with the aim of ensuring non-discriminatory access to the market – new transmission system operator to start operations in 1.1.2020

1300 km of pipeline

220 delivery points


2 cross-border connections: Imatra & Balticconnector











Principles for gas transmission: Safety, reliability of the delivery, cost-efficiency
